- ▶ Up to 20 participants are accepted each year
- ▶ Open to current teaching artists, practicing artists interested in teaching artistry, and arts educators

WHAT IS A MASTER TEACHING ARTIST?

A Master Teaching Artist is a special designation certified by Arts for Learning WNY to Teaching Artists across the region to recognize their dedication to continued education and expertise in both traditional educational principles and their artform. Master Teaching Artists will recertify every 4 years to ensure each individual is up to date on best practices in the education field.

Participants in the Master Teaching Artist Training program will complete at least 40 hours of specialized professional learning in:

- Connection to New York State and Next Generation Learning Standards
- Classroom management
- Lesson plan modification and adaptation for differentiated learners
- Lesson planning and residency planning
- Justice, Equity, Diversity, Inclusion, and Innovation (JEDI) practices in order to create belonging and social-emotional supports in the classroom
- Lincoln Center Education Teaching Artististry nationally recognized principles
